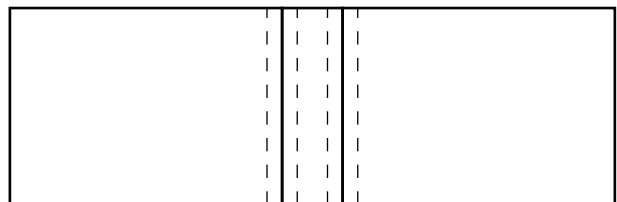


PRELIMINARY ENTERANCE EXAMINATION ASSIGNMENTS FOR ARCHITECTURE DEPARTMENTS

The preliminary assignments consist of creating a portfolio about yourself. The purpose of the portfolio is to tell about your personality and your latent design skills. The work in your portfolio includes three preliminary assignments. The instructions for these assignments are found on the following page. The portfolio is constructed of cardboard according to the instructions below.

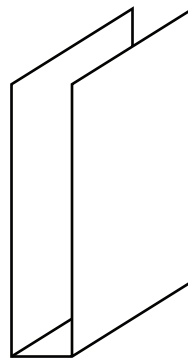
1. Cut three rectangular pieces out of cardboard (thickness approximately 3 mm), of which two measure 360 x 260 mm and one measures 80 x 260 mm.

2. Tape the pieces together to form a folder shown in figure 1 by using wide and strong tape. The end result is a stiff and easily opened folder.

3. The drawing sheet from Assignment 1 is attached to the inner surface of the folder on the left-hand side when opened.

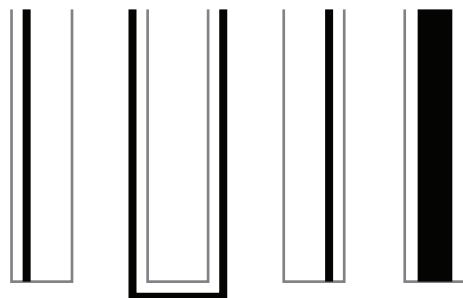

4. The drawings from Assignment 2 are attached to the exterior surfaces of the folder.

5. The drawing from Assignment 3 is attached to the inner surface of the folder on the right-hand side when opened.

6. The miniature model from Assignment 3 is attached to the inner surface of the spine of the folder so that the folder can still be opened.

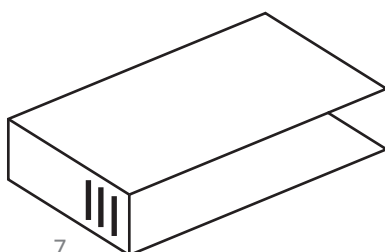

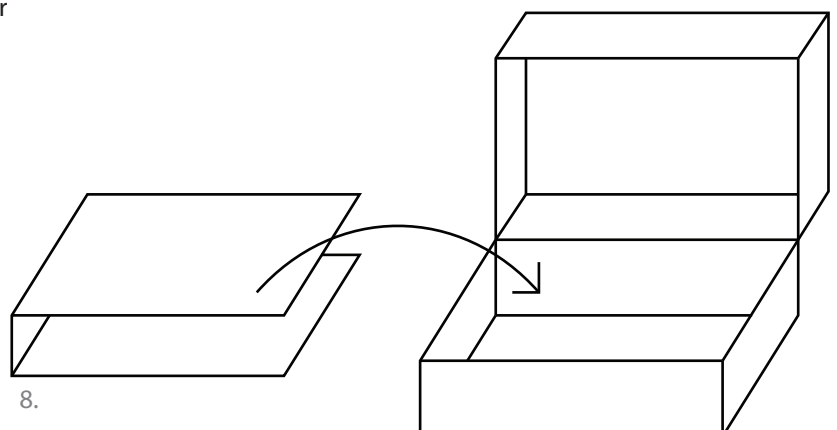
7. On the outer surface of the spine of the folder you need to write the following information:

Last name
 First names
 Social security code
 (if you have one; if not, your date of birth)
 Signature

8. The completed portfolio is placed in a postal package box number 3 (384 x 288 x 96 mm) or equivalent.

ASSIGNMENTS REGARDING PORTFOLIO

ASSIGNMENT 1 A SELF-PORTRAIT

Create an abstract and personal self-portrait.

Use a horizontally placed sheet, size 340 x 240 mm. Free technique.

The sheet is attached to the inner surface of the portfolio, on the left-hand side when opened.

ASSIGNMENT 2 AN INTERESTING SITE

Find a site from your neighborhood which intrigues your imagination. View the location from different perspectives and present your observations in drawings. Take assignment 3 into consideration when choosing your site.

Use a graphite pencil.

The drawings are attached to the exterior surfaces of the folder.

ASSIGNMENT 3 A CONSTRUCTION AND LOCATION

Present your view on what kind of construction could be built on the site you have chosen in assignment 2.

Present your ideas with sketch-like drawings and a miniature model. The method of drawing and the materials of the model can be freely chosen.

The drawing is to be drawn on a horizontally placed sheet of size 340 x 240 mm, and is attached to the inner surface of the folder on the right-hand side when opened.

The model is attached to the inner surface of the spine of the folder so that the folder can still be opened. The model needs to fit inside the postal package box number 3 together with the folder.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Assignments 1-3 are evaluated as an entity. Attention will be paid to the quality of personal expression and clear presentation.
